





THE GROWING DEADDICTION MARKET

Pharmacist calling

Opportunities abound in the market for the bounty hunter pharmacist. The deaddiction market is now growing fast and there is a need for products and services – pharmacists can address this growing market. Availability of money and access to various chemicals of addiction has increased vulnerability to addiction: in fact, substance abuse disorder has become a most worrying trend in society. Addiction starts as a non-serious dalliance with the substance of abuse such as alcohol or methamphetamine. The addiction habit takes root due to physiological dependence created by the chemicals of abuse. Once addiction takes root, the victim tries many routes to de-addict since addiction causes trauma, loss in self-esteem and status, breakdown of relationships and financial stress. This is where pharmacists can play a role in the addiction sphere to help addicts kick their habit.



Opioid Addiction

Opioids are a group of natural, semi-synthetic or synthetic medicines that are derived or mimic poppy plant (*Papaver somniferum*), they are used mainly for pain relief by doctors. However, they have huge addiction potential due to euphoria experience caused by opioid intake. This has also led to opioid drug overdose problem. Examples of opioid substances are: oxycodone, morphine, hydrocodone, codeine, heroin, morphine, fentanyl and tramadol.

Opioid addiction needs to be treated in special settings and drugs used include methadone, buprenorphine and naltrexone. The deaddiction drugs reduce cravings and also block effects of opioids to help maintain abstinence.

Alcohol addiction

There is a Japanese proverb that says: 'first you take the alcohol, then the alcohol take alcohol and finally alcohol takes you'. Alcohol is described as a toxic psychoactive substance with dependence producing properties, as per WHO. Harmful use of alcohol causes about 30 lakh deaths per annum in the world.

Drugs used to treat alcohol addiction are disulfiram, naltrexone and acamprostate. Other drugs like topiramate and fluoxetine also help reduce drinking habit.



Nicotine Addiction

The main route of nicotine use is through smoking. Nicotine cravings is well documented among smokers and other users. Varenicline and other nicotine replacement therapy are used to help smokers quit.

There are many other substance use disorders: cannabis use disorder, stimulant use disorder (cocaine and amphetamine), anxiolytics-sedatives-hypnotics use disorder, hallucinogen use disorder (example certain mushrooms), caffeine addiction and inhalant use disorders.


